North America

Who was Neil Armstrong and what did he discover?



moon

- A few people had travelled to **space** but no-one had been to the **moon**.
- **Neil Armstrong**, Buzz Aldrin and Michael Collins set out on their **mission**, Apollo 11.
- The **astronauts** reached the **moon**.
- **Neil Armstrong** was the first man to walk on the **moon** and said 'one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind.'

1451 Born in Italy	1465 Wanted to be a sailor so taught himself maths, geography and astronomy .	1492 Set off on his expedition to Asia .	1492 (5 weeks later) Landed on an island which he thought was Asia . It was actually North America .	1506 Died

1930 Born in USA	1949 Trained to be a pilot .	1962 Trained to be an astronaut .	1969 Headed off on his mission with Buzz Aldrin and Michael Collins and was the first man to walk on the moon .	2012 Died
