SCARLET FEVER

We have been informed by the Local authority that rates of Scarlet Fever continue to be unusually high for this time of year. Scarlet Fever is **highly contagious**.

Please be aware of the following signs and symptoms:

- **high temperature, rash, sore throat, flushed cheeks and swollen tongue.**

If your child has suspected Scarlet Fever they should not attend school until 24 hours after beginning antibiotic treatment.

You must seek medical advice if you suspect Scarlet Fever.
