What should I already know?

- Some people believe there are people who are chosen for a special purpose by God.
- A prophet is someone who talks about God’s plan or will.
- Some people believe that God has made a promise between himself and his people.
- Some people talk to God in different ways and for different reasons.
- Books and stories can have different meanings to different people.
- Religious stories can help us to understand religious beliefs.
- Stories from long ago can be applied to modern life.
- Wisdom means knowledge that comes from experience.
- Guidance means advice, information or rules given by someone in authority.
- Prophets and gurus are considered to share God’s wisdom and guidance, having had it revealed to them by God.

Guru	A Sikh religious learner or teacher
Messenger	A person or being who bring important messages
Prophet	A person who receives messages from or speaks to God, often about the future.
chosen	having been selected as the best or most appropriate.
Guru Granth Sahib	the central religious scripture of Sikhism, treated as the eternal and living Guru after the final human Guru
Guru Nanak	<i>an Indian spiritual teacher, mystic and poet</i> , who is regarded as the founder of Sikhism and is the first of the ten Sikh Gurus
Messiah	the promised <u>deliverer</u> of the Jewish nation <u>prophesied</u> in the Hebrew Bible.
Qur’an	Islam’s central religious text, believed by Muslims to be the literal word of God (Allah) revealed to the Prophet Muhammad through the angel Gabriel
value	the regard that something is held to deserve; the importance, worth, or usefulness of something.
